Evangelicals Understanding Catholicism

A seminar on Catholicism will be held on Saturday, April 28th, 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon, and on Sunday, April 29th, 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The Saturday session (Part A) will provide an introduction to the Catechism, followed by a look at Catholic beliefs and practices as expressed via the Apostles' Creed. BETHANY MANOR in Saskatoon hosts a book evening Friday, April 20, at 7 pm, for FLIGHT, a 735-page book of translations and summaries by writer-editor Harold Jantz, all from the *Mennonitische Rundschau*. They tell the story of the Russian Mennonite community facing the Soviet empire in 1929-30. This was the period of a mass flight of Mennonites to Moscow, the refugee movement to Paraguay, Brazil and Canada, the beginning of exile for many who remained in Russia, and a 1930 Mennonite World Relief Conference in Danzig. **FLIGHT is about suffering, perseverance of faith, and starting again in the face of adversity. For survivors or descendants of that time, FLIGHT will have great interest.**
