No experience necessary...honest.

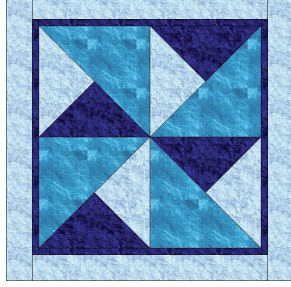
Anyone allowed to use a needle and thread and scissors are welcome and not just ladies but gentlemen too.
