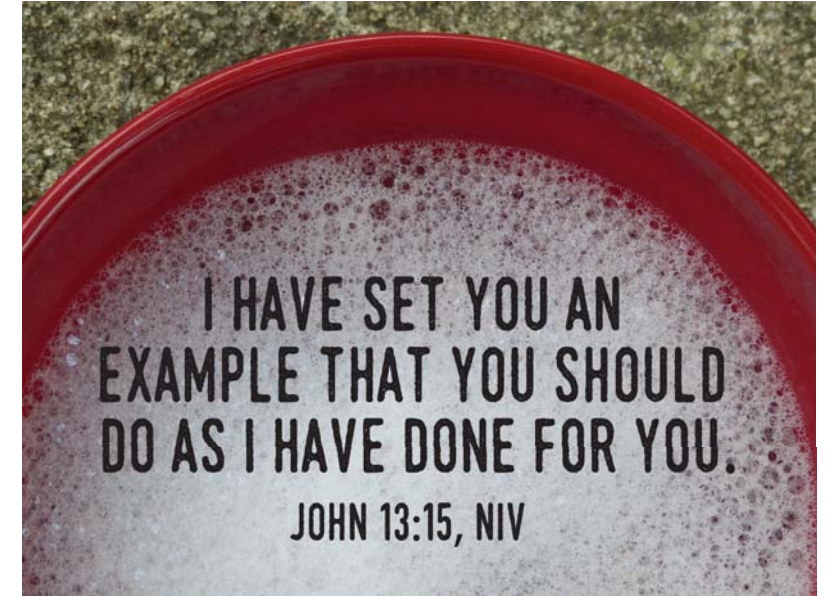

March 6, 2019, Ash Wednesday
