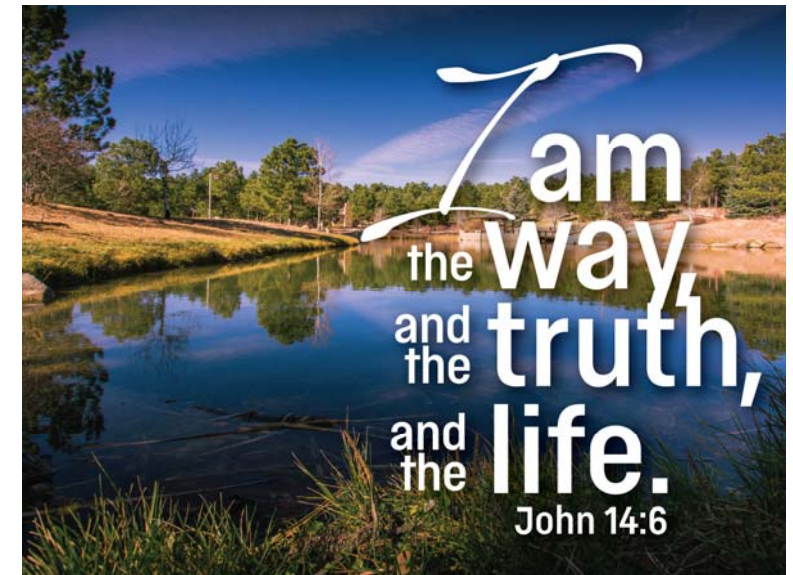

SEASON OF LENT

March 24, 2019, Third Sunday in Lent

Isa. 55:1-9; Ps. 63:1-8; 1 Cor. 10:1-13;

Luke 13:1-9
